THE BLITZ PRESEASON TOP 30

1. ALABAMA (SEC): Last year the Crimson Tide underachieved by losing 3 games but it's difficult seeing that happen two years in a row. Tide coach Nick Saban has a very solid team and the big question will be at QB where AJ McCarron and Phillip Sims will battle for the starting job.

2. OKLAHOMA (BIG 12): The Sooners come into the 2011 season with a lot of talent returning. Starting quarterback Landry Jones, WR Ryan Broyles and LB Travis Lewis headline a deep and talented roster for Bob Stoops' Oklahoma Sooners.

3. FLORIDA STATE (ACC): Coming off a 10 win season and with 9 starters back on both offense and defense, Jimbo Fisher's second season as the Seminoles head coach could turn out to be very special, but the Oklahoma game on Sept 17th looms large.

4. LSU (SEC): Everyone knows that LSU has super talent on their roster, but the big question is who will lead them from the QB position. Incumbent, Jordan Jefferson is coming off a great Cotton Bowl performance, but Zach Mettenberger will battle him.

5. OREGON (PAC-12): With QB Darron Thomas and RB LaMichael James returning, scoring points should not be a problem. Defensively, coach Chip Kelly might have some retooling to do. The opener vs LSU will show if the Ducks are back.

6. NEBRASKA (BIG TEN): A former Big Ten player (Bo Pelini) will lead the Huskers into the Big Ten Conference. Nebraska will be the team to beat in the Big Ten Legends Division if QB Taylor Martinez can play like he did early in the 2010 season but Pelini must replace key players on both sides of the ball.

7. OKLAHOMA STATE (BIG 12): Don't look now but Mike Gundy has built a solid football program in Stillwater. With QB Brandon Weeden and WR Justin Blackmon returning, the "Bedlam Game" between the Sooners and OSU might decide the Big 12.

8. WISCONSIN (BIG TEN): With QB Russell Wilson's arrival in Madison to go along with tailbacks Montee Ball and James White, Wisconsin should battle Ohio State for the top spot in the Big Ten Leaders Division and a spot in the inaugural Big Ten Championship Game in Indianapolis.

9. STANFORD (PAC-12): The good news is that Andrew Luck is back. The bad news is that Jim Harbaugh is not. David Shaw replaces Harbaugh as the Cardinal head coach and he'll have a tough task because he has to replace 7 starters on defense.

10. GEORGIA (SEC): QB Aaron Murray returns for his sophomore season and if he can get his line to protect him, the Bulldogs should compete with South Carolina and Florida for the SEC Eastern Division crown.

11. BOISE STATE (MWC): When Boise State made the decision to move to the MWC, they had no idea that all 3 of the MWC powers (Utah, BYU and TCU) would be leaving. Oh well at least they get 1 year with TCU. The Broncos open up with Georgia in Atlanta with QB Kellen Moore back for his senior season.

12. OHIO STATE (BIG TEN): The loss of Jim Tressel and Terrelle Pryor hurts, but new coach Luke Fickell inherits a very talented roster and if they can embrace the "us against the world" mentality, the Buckeyes could claw their way to another great season on the field that has become common place. In Columbus.

13. VIRGINIA TECH (ACC): The Hokies lose three offensive stars in Tyrod Taylor, Darren Evans and Ryan Williams but the offensive line returns as do 7 defensive starters so don't be surprised if Frank Beamer's team is in contention down the stretch.

14. ARKANSAS (SEC): Tyler Wilson replaces Ryan Mallett as the Hogs QB but coach Bobby Petrino believes that he is more than capable. The injury to RB Knile Davis could be a greater concern, however. With 8 returning defensive starters, Arkansas should again be a contender in the SEC West.

15. MICHIGAN STATE (BIG TEN): Mark Dantonio's Michigan State Spartans return the nucleus of the offense as QB Kirk Cousins and RB's LaVeon Bell and Edwin Baker return. It's on defense where they will be inexperienced and vulnerable.

16. TEXAS A&M (BIG 12): Mike Sherman has to be looking forward to the 2011 season because he has 10 starters back on offense (including QB Ryan Tannehill, WR Jeff Fuller and RB Cyrus Gray) and 8 starters returning on defense.

17. SOUTH CAROLINA (SEC): Coming off 2 losses to Auburn and Florida State, you would think South Carolina would be feeling bad. They don't. Steve Spurrier knows that with QB Stephen Garcia, RB Marcus Lattimore, WR Alshon Jeffery and freshman DE Jadeveon Clowney making plays, the Gamecocks will be very difficult to beat.

18. NOTRE DAME (INDEPENDENT): For the first time since Lou Holtz was the head coach, Notre Dame seems to be at a place where winning on a consistent basis is back. Brian Kelly is a great recruiter and a great sidelines coach. With Dayne Crist and Michael Floyd back, the Irish should put a lot of points on the scoreboard in 2011.

19. TEXAS (BIG 12): This roster is just too good and too deep to have another sub-par season. QB Garrett Gilbert must improve to get Texas back where we became accustomed to seeing the Longhorns, which was competing for Big 12 crowns and national titles.

20. SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA (PAC-12): Lane Kiffin begins his 2nd season at USC and he'll have junior QB, Matt Barkley leading an offense that should be even better than they were in 2010. The Trojans have WR Robert Woods and RB's Marc Tyler and Dillon Baxter coming back as well, which bodes well.

21. MISSOURI (BIG 12): Losing QB Blaine Gabbert is tough but the Tigers should still be pretty good offensively with 9 starters returning. The battle for the starting QB should be interesting between James Franklin and Ashton Glaser.

22. FLORIDA (SEC): Will Muschamp takes over for Urban Meyer in Gainesville. He installed a pro-style offense and then hired former Notre Dame Head Coach Charlie Weis to run it. Both of those moves will help QB John Brantley. Defensively, the Gators will get a boost due to Muschamp's roots being from that side of the ball.

23. TCU (MWC): Coach Gary Patterson will use 2011 breaking in a new QB (Casey Pachall) and allow Tank Carder and Tanner Brock to lead the defense as TCU competes in their final season in the Mountain West Conference before heading to the Big East in 2012.

24. MISSISSIPPI STATE (SEC): With 14 starters back (7 on offense and 7 on defense), Coach Dan Mullen should at least come close to duplicating last season's 9-4 record. Defense was and should continue to be the strong point.

25. PENN STATE (BIG TEN): The quarterback battle between Matt McGloin and Rob Bolton will make the headlines but it's the Nittany Lion defense that will decide most of the games as Joe Paterno returns for his 46th season in Happy Valley.

26. WEST VIRGINIA (BIG EAST): QB Geno Smith is back and new WVU head coach, Dana Holgorsen should be able to further develop his passing and improve the entire offense at West Virginia. The LSU game will be a gauge to see how good WVU will be.

27. ARIZONA STATE (PAC-12): Arizona State should battle USC and Utah as the best team in the Pac-12 South Division. With 10 starters back on offense and 9 on defense, this should be an experienced team that can beat a few of the teams they lost close games to in 2010.

28. MIAMI, FL (ACC): Al Golden comes to Miami from Temple where he rebuilt that program. The talent is on the roster but the confidence seemed to be lacking. If QB Jacory Harris can cut down on his interceptions, the Hurricanes should compete for the ACC Coastal Division with Virginia Tech and North Carolina.

29. TENNESSEE (SEC): Tyler Bray is the key for the Vols in 2011. If he can continue to develop as a QB and if RB Tauren Poole has another 1,000 season, UT will score a lot of points. It's the defense that seems to be the biggest question mark heading into the season.

30. SOUTH FLORIDA (BIG EAST): The Skip Holtz era begins year two and with the elusive B.J. Daniel running the offense, the USF Bulls should fight it out with West Virginia and Pittsburgh for the Big East title and a spot in a BCS Game.
